# New Life Development Services



**New Life Development Services** seeks to serve the people of Liberia in areas of humanitarian need in the wake of their 13 year civil war, as they seek to rebuild families, renew business, equip school and gather the church.

New Life Development

Liberia began a civil war in 1990 and the United Nations estimates 250,000 people died as political leaders fought for control. In 2006 Ellen Johnson became President and a new era of peace began. Currently Liberians who fled the country are beginning to return to find few resources but a desire to start new. New Live Ministry Center with Pastor Nathan Mahteh with Pastor Russell Doe of St. Paul Minnesota also seeks to support families, schools, small business and the community rebuild.

### Community Center

As the town of Barnersville grows with the return of many people who fled Liberia during the civil war, there is a growing need for a space for these businesses to begin and the community to gather. There are currently plans for a library and an internet/computer use area.

### Education

As schools begging to open and student again return their focus on their futures, many students need assistance with school fees. In Liberia all schooling is paid for by families until the post graduate level. Schools are also short of books and other basic supplies. NLDS seeks to work alongside school administrators to meet the needs of faculty and students as they see more children return to school.



### Family Needs

NLDS seeks to provide humanitarian needs like clothing, shoes, household items and children's items for families of the congregation and community in need.

### Economic Empowerment

NLDS is currently working with several entrepreneurs eager to start small business that will need key needs in the town of Barnersville a town of about 20,000 people in the suburbs of Monrovia the capital of Liberia. However due to a lack of jobs and resources many people of this large suburb still travel 12 miles into town for even basic food and family needs. These entrepreneurs eager to begin small business are willing to work with church leadership to receive micro grants to begin these businesses. The church would like to support the growth of a sewing/tailor shop, a carpentry shop, an auto-mechanical service station, some small supplies stores, an educational preschool, an internet café and many other business ideas.
